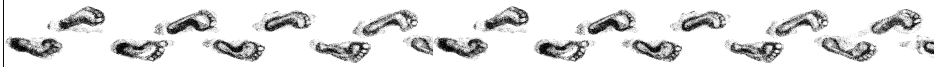


Summer Sunday School 2009

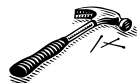
